The Wheelhouse contains helm and L shaped seating that converts to a double berth with sliding outside access doors either side and forward and aft door access to cabins. A Storage module with work surface is located on the port side. Accommodation in the front cabin contains a galley to port with toilet/shower to starboard. Accommodation to the rear cabin is two single berths either side of the aft dressing table.
