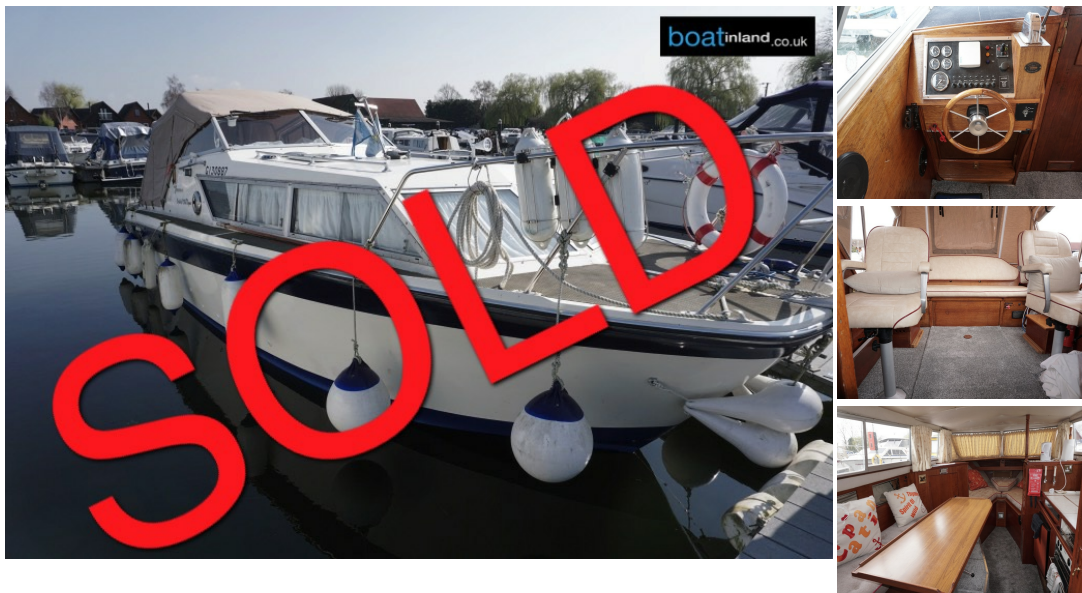


## Seamaster - 813
